LULAC and Pima Community College has also been a pioneer in supporting the creation of the Hispanic Student Endowment Fund at Pima County Community College. We have hosted a Young Readers Program, provided bike helmets, child safety car and booster seats, computers and holiday food boxes to needy families.
